Metropolitan Branch Trail Vision / Proposed Schedule

Vision

The Metropolitan Branch Trail (MBT) is one of the District's most important non-motorized transportation projects. The trail will link Union Station and the National Mall with downtown Silver Spring and the Capital Crescent Trail, forming a loop around and within the Northwest and Northeast sectors of Washington, DC.

When finished, the **Metropolitan Branch Trail** will be a car-free urban thoroughfare for walkers, joggers, and bicyclists. The trail will accommodate bicycle commuters in the morning and evening hours, as well as pedestrians seeking access to the seven adjacent Metrorail stations. All day long, DC residents will use the trail for exercise, recreation, fun, and local travel to nearby businesses, jobs and community facilities.
